### Dr. Richard P. Heitzenrater

Recently retired as the William Kellon Quick Professor of Church History and Wesley Studies at the Duke University Divinity School, Dr. Heitzenrater is perhaps best known for “breaking the code” of John Wesley’s personal diaries. While at Duke he explored Wesley’s life in authentic manuscripts and edited the seven volume *Journal and Diaries of John Wesley*. Prior to that he taught for 16 years at Southern Methodist University.

He has been the general editor of the Wesley Works Editorial Project, producing the *Bicentennial Edition of the Works of John Wesley*, as well as the co-chair of the Wesley Studies Group of the Oxford Institute of Methodist Theological Studies.

Dr. Heitzenrater has lectured at many distinguished institutions throughout the world. He has published over a dozen books including *Wesley and the People Called Methodists*, which is now translated into six languages.



### Dr. S T Kimbrough, Jr.

Internationally known as one of America’s most recorded baritone singers, Dr. Kimbrough has authored and will present the one-person musical drama, *Sweet Singer*, depicting the life and work of Charles Wesley. He premiered this musical drama to a sold-out Carnegie Hall audience in New York City and has since toured the world presenting over 500 performances. For a number of years he was leading baritone of the Bonn Opera Company in Germany and has performed on opera, musical, and concert stages in Europe, North and South America and Asia.

An internationally known scholar Dr. Kimbrough is the author of some forty books and numerous articles on voice, music, theology, church history, missions, and biblical studies. His books on Charles Wesley include: *The Unpublished Poetry of Charles Wesley* (3 vols.); *Songs for the Poor*; *Charles Wesley: Poet and Theologian*; *A Heart to Praise My God*. He has served churches in Alabama, North Carolina, New Jersey, and Germany, has been the Associate General Secretary for Mission Evangelism of the General Board of Global Missions, and has taught on numerous theological faculties in the USA.
