~ TOURS AND TALKS ~

Fort King George

From 1721 until 1736, Fort King George was the southern outpost of the British Empire in North America and the first English settlement in Georgia. A museum of local history and authentic replicas of the cypress block-house, barracks and palisaded earthen fort make this a historic highlight.



Hofwyl-Broadfield Plantation

Built in the early 1800's, this beautiful plantation represents history and culture of Georgia's rice coast. Rice was grown here until 1913.

Maritime Center at Historic Coast Guard Station

Listed on the National Register of Historic Places, this Roosevelt -era Coast Guard Station features 7 galleries that explain the importance of our coastal ecosystem and its preservation, the coast's military history, and the important role played by the U.S. Coast Guard.



Arthur J. Moore Methodist Museum and Archives

Many exhibits explore St. Simons Island history, while other exhibits highlight the history of the Methodist Church.

Fort Frederica National Monument

When it was built in 1736, Fort Frederica was the most expensive military installation in British North America. Stroll along the town's streets to view the sites of homes, barracks, tabby fortifications and the magazine. Learn to play colonial games such as farkle and fox & geese.



St. Simons Lighthouse Museum

Standing 104 feet, the Lighthouse was built in 1872. It still serves as a navigation aid to ships entering St. Simons Sound - casting its beam 23 miles out to sea. Climb the 129 steps to the top of the lighthouse for a breathtaking view.



Jekyll Island National Historic Landmark District

Embark on a journey into the glittering world of an upscale 19th century resort - the winter retreat of the Macys, Goulds, Goodyears and Astors. Preserved are 34 historic structures and 53 known archaeological sites.

Christ Church, Frederica

The second oldest Episcopal Church in Georgia and the third oldest in the country.



Bloody Marsh

Site of the 1742 battle between the English and northern advancing Spanish troops.
