PROPERTY IMPROVEMENTS TOTAL: \$430,950

• Reynolds Rooms and Apartments: \$37,400

Complete renovation of 12 rooms and 5 apartments: paint, flooring, micro-fridge and cabinet, replace vanity and bedding.

• Brown Meeting Room: \$36,000

Renovate Classrooms 5-6 with new lighting, ceiling tiles, paint, flooring and replace glass windows.

 Pitts Office, Walker Lobby and Dining Rooms Generator: \$79,000

Replace existing diesel generator with natural gas generator that will operate our main building during a power outage.

• Gholson Pre-school: \$13,550

Replace the 40-year windows. Current mechanisms do not operate the window safely. Replace the fence surrounding the pre-school.

• Serving Line Solarium: \$15,000

Reroof the solarium with a flat roof over the serving line.

• Upgrade Serving Lines: \$145,000

Upgrade the serving lines, soup and salad bars and beverage stations to provide better service to our guests.

• Strickland Auditorium: \$30,000

Replace the HVAC

• Various Mechanical Equipment: \$75,000

During the course of the year, HVAC systems, commercial hot water heaters, pumps and motors fail and need to be replaced.

CAPITAL PROJECT

Walker Lobby Porte Cochere: \$150,000

enhance safety, pedestrian protection and traffic flow for the registration and dining area. The design will be similar to the Porte Cochere for the D. Abbott Turner Lodge.
